

Who will deliver the library materials? Library and COA volunteers will deliver and retrieve the materials.

What type of materials can I borrow?

All circulating library materials, including books, magazines, audiobooks, dvds, and music cds will be delivered for a three-week loan period.

Materials will typically be delivered and retrieved on the same day. We can select items for you by title or author, or if you prefer, library staff will select a variety of materials based on your reading interests and preferences.

When can I expect delivery to my home? When your enrollment form is received, someone will contact you within one month to discuss your reading preferences and determine when a volunteer is available to begin delivering materials to you.

For any questions or concerns, please contact one of the individuals listed below. Any information provided, including reading interests or titles, will be treated confidentially by all participants in the program, including volunteers.


